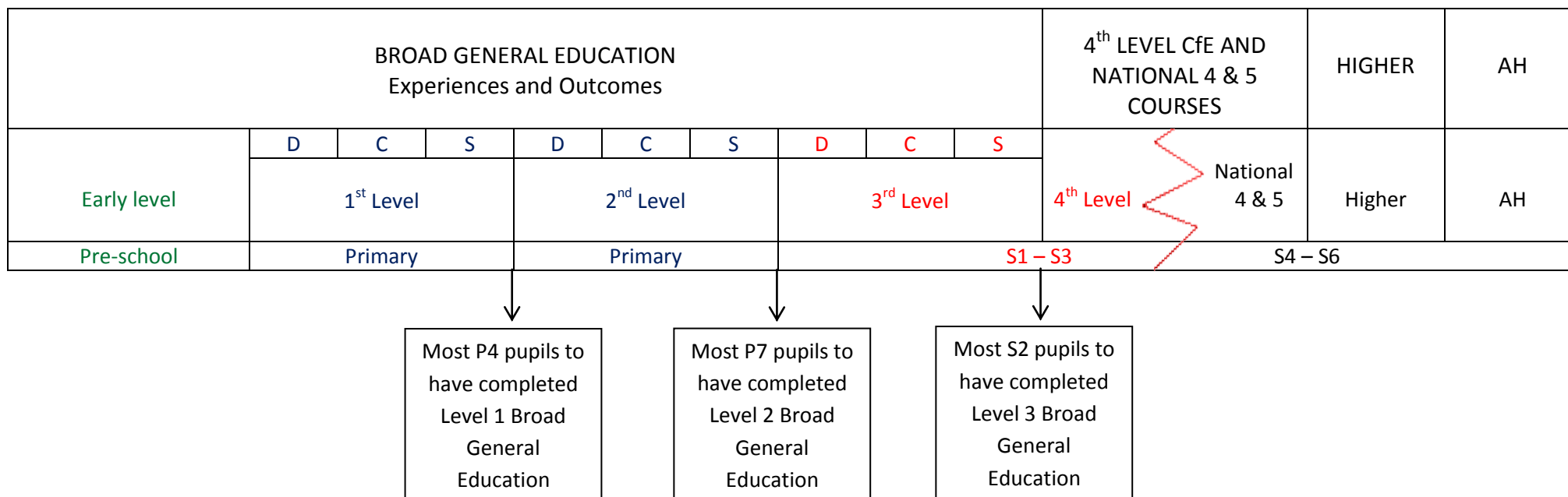


3-18 Pupil Progress

This is a visual representation which aims to simplify the school curriculum structure. Individual pupils may progress through the stages outlined below at a faster or slower pace than national expectations. During S3, most pupils will be completing their Broad General Education 4th level outcomes as well as beginning to prepare for National 4/5 courses.



D = Developing: The learner has started to engage in the work of the new level and is beginning to make progress in an increasing amount of outcomes across the breadth of learning described in the experiences and outcomes for the level.

C = Consolidating: The learner has achieved a breadth of learning across many of the experiences and outcomes. The learner can apply what he/she has learned in familiar situations. The learner is beginning to undertake more challenging learning and is also beginning to apply learning in unfamiliar contexts.

S = Secure: The learner has achieved a breadth of learning across almost all the experiences and outcomes for the level, including any significant aspects of the curriculum area. The learner has responded consistently well to the level of challenge set out in these experiences and outcomes. The learner has moved forward to more challenging learning in some aspects and can apply what he/she has learned in new and unfamiliar situations.
