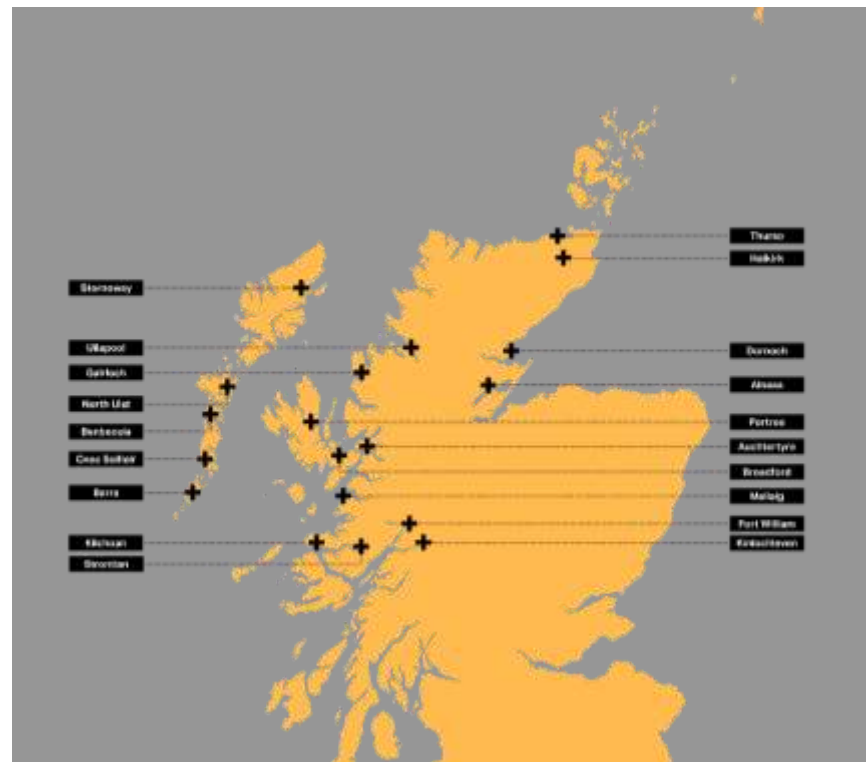

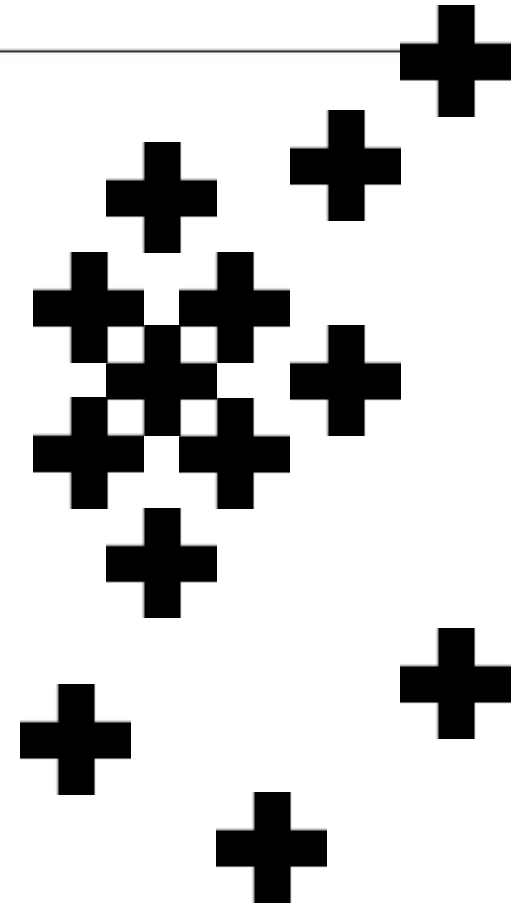

Curriculum areas available to you on S3

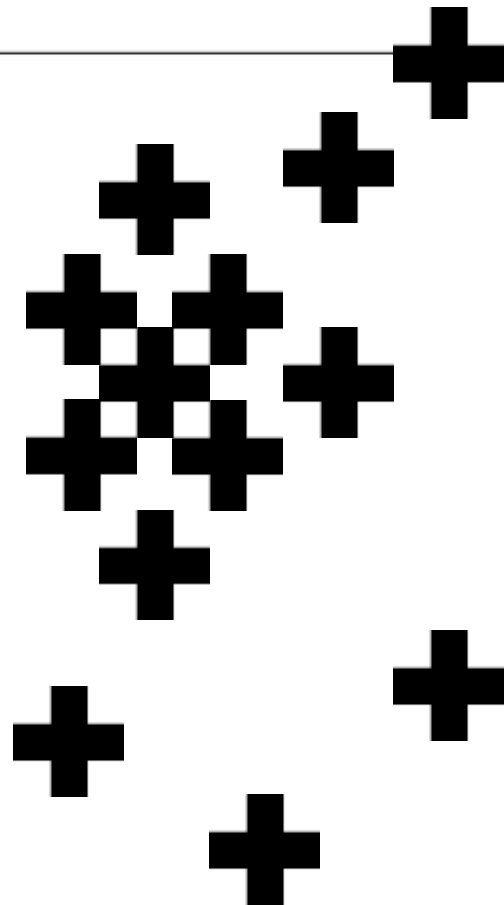
- + Academic Development (N5, Highers)

Maritime Skills For Work (National 5)

- + Two-year course delivered over S3 & S4
- + The operation of boats and equipment
- + Boat handling and the use of ropes, wires and chains
- + Effective anchoring, mooring and securing a vessel
- + An introduction to marine navigation, and how to factor in weather conditions
- + Safety aspects of job roles in the maritime sector including:
 - + Safe working practices on board ship
 - + Life-saving principles
 - + Basic first aid
 - + Basic fire safety



S3

NPA Construction Craft & Technician (SCQF Level 4)

Activities include:

- + Brickwork – Lay bricks and blocks
- + Carpentry & Joinery - Install second fixing components.
- + Painting & Decorating - Apply paint systems by brush and roller
- + Personal Development: Understanding Industry

S4

NPA Construction Skills (SCQF Level 5)

- + This Course introduces learners to craft techniques in the construction industry, and the opportunity to combine these with practical skills.
- + It develops knowledge and understanding of a range of construction disciplines and focuses on skills and the application of learning that is essential for careers in the sector.
- + This NPA provides a wide choice in sector areas such as carpentry and joinery, painting, brickwork, plasterwork, roof tiling and stonemasonry

S5/6

NPA Built Environment (SCQF Level 5)

- + This course develops knowledge and understanding through project-based learning and introduces transferable construction skills — such as planning, communication and employability.
- + The areas covered include principles of building design, 3D modelling for the built environment, construction methods, and sustainability.
- + This qualification is designed to inspire and enthuse learners to consider a career in the Built Environment.

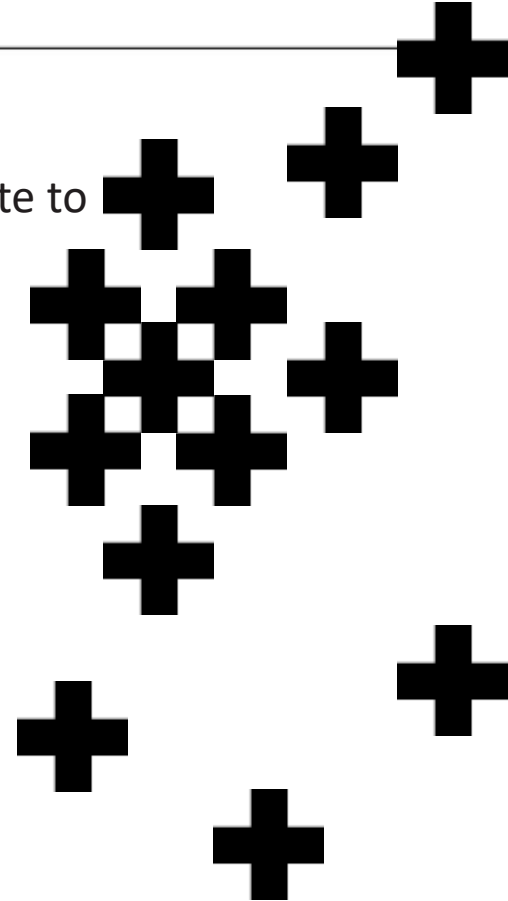


Horse Care

You will be working with horses and will study modules appropriate to your interests and current equestrian skills.

Units Include:

- + Horse identification and handling a quiet horse safely
- + Assist with grooming a quiet horse
- + Tack and tacking up
- + Stable routine
- + Horse health
- + Watering and feeding
- + Tacking up for ridden competition work
- + Horse care: lunging
- + Horse care: trimming, turnout and clipping
